Expressing Obligation with "Hay que" and "Tener que" AND Prohibition with "Se prohibe"

Practice Expressing Obligation:

- One must carry a backpack
- One must help the teacher (f.).
- They (m) have to get good grades.
- Ms. Parker has to arrive to school early.
- We have to use the computer.

- Hay que llevar una mochila.
- Hay que ayudar a la maestra.
- Ellos tienen que sacar buenas notas.
- Srta. Parker tiene que llegar temprano a la escuela.
- Nosotros tenemos que usar la computadora.

When do you use "se prohibe"?

- To talk about things someone must NOT do.
- Examples:
 - *It is forbiden to talk in class.

Se prohibe hablar en clase.

The 1 Way to Express Prohibition

• <u>Use se prohibe +</u> <u>infinitive</u> if there is no specific <u>subject.</u>
