- 1st Quarter (9 weeks / approximately 4-5 weeks each)

## 7<sup>th</sup> grade

- Unit 2: How do I talk about school?
  - Lesson 5 and 6: Days of the week, telling the months and seasons. Conjugation of basic AR verbs.
  - Lesson 6: Describing the weather. Conjugation of the verb ESTAR
  - Lesson 8: Telling time.
  - Lesson 9: Verbs (ER, IR) and formation of basic sentences. Some irregular verbs.
  - Lesson 10: Talking about the school. (Classes, school supplies, activities, etc.)

- Student are evaluated in the 4 modalities of communication: Speaking, Writing, Reading and Listening comprehension. They will also be evaluated on Culture. STUDENTS GRADES ARE DIVIDED IN MASTERY AND PRACTICE. Mastery grades are 10, 20 or 30 points depending on the difficulty and time used.
- Student will have HW every day or at least three times a week. Languages is a subject the needs to be reviewed and practiced on a daily bases.




