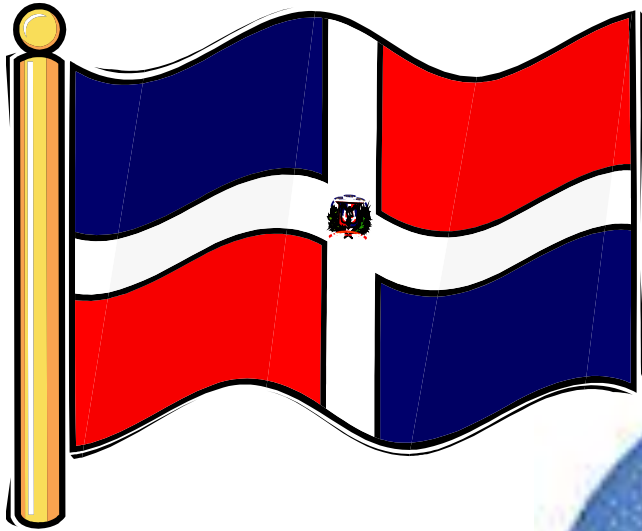

República Dominicana

- ▶ DR has coasts on both sides the Atlantic and the Caribbean Ocean.
 - ▶ It shares the island of **LA HISPANIOLA (LA ESPAÑOLA)** with Haiti.
 - ▶ Los **dominicanos** are famous for their hospitality.
 - ▶ El **merengue (music and dance)** is originally from DR.
 - ▶ It is the most famous of the Antilles. It is inhabited by the indigenous tribes of the **TAINOS**.
 - ▶ The island was discovered by Cristóbal Colón in December 1492 and he gave the name to the island “La Española”.
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Continuación

- ▶ DR broke from Haiti in 1844 and became independent from Spain in 1865
- ▶ The capital of DR is **Santo Domingo**, it is the oldest continuously inhabited city in this hemisphere.
- ▶ Tourism is growing at a rapid pace.
