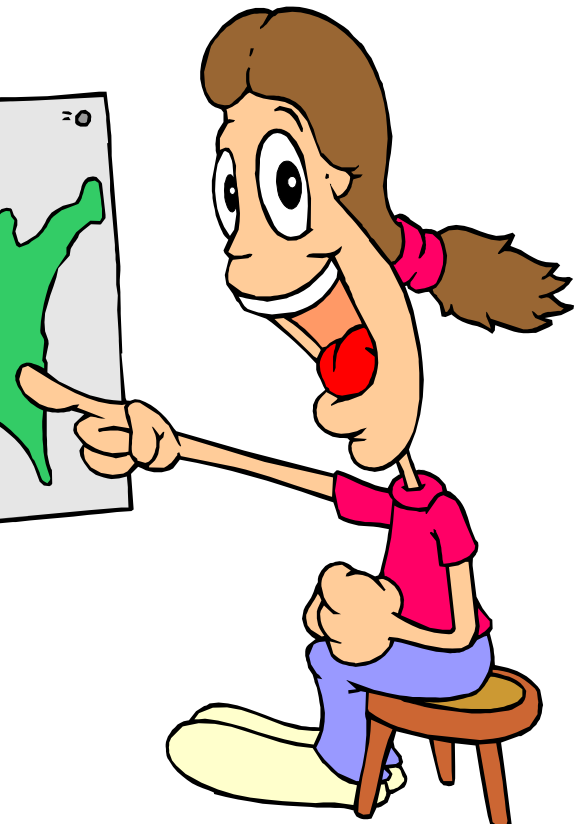
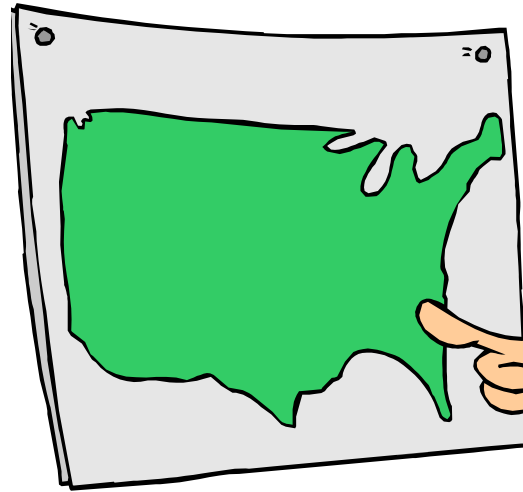
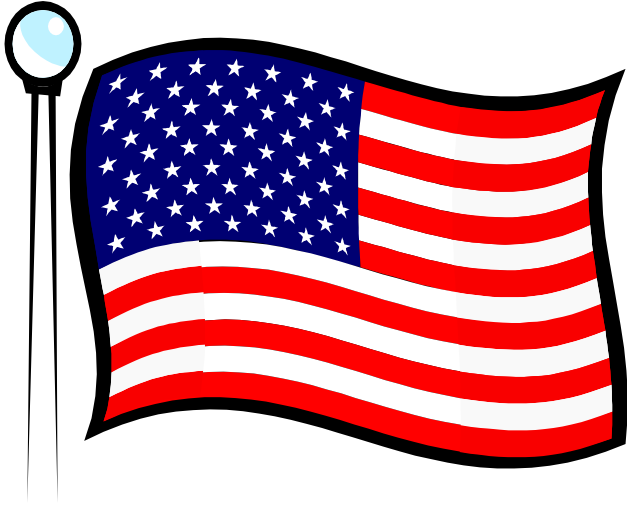

- It is called the “language of Cervantes”, the author of the famous Don Quijote de la Mancha.
